Describe the nominee’s perspective on the future of retirement in Canada and how their work contributes to advancing that vision.

C. Letter of Support

At least one letter of support from a peer, colleague, supervisor, client, or collaborator. (Additional letters may be included.)

4. Eligibility Confirmation

- The nominee is 40 years of age or younger as of April 30, 2026
- The nominee works primarily on Canadian pension or retirement matters
- The nominee is not an ACPM employee, Board member, or judge
- The nominee has not received this Award in the past three years

5. Evaluation Criteria

Nominations will be evaluated based on:

- Demonstrated impact
- Leadership and initiative
- Innovation and forward-thinking
- Alignment with ACPM's mission to advance retirement security in Canada

Selected recipients will:

- Be recognized at the ACPM 2026 National Conference in Montréal
- Receive complimentary registration to attend the Conference
- Receive a two-year ACPM membership
- Be profiled across ACPM communications (website, newsletter, LinkedIn)
