Re: Stakeholder Consultation on CAPSA Draft 2026 - 2029 Strategic Plan

Thank you for the opportunity to provide comments on the draft Strategic Plan. ACPM appreciates the work that has gone into the document, and we are pleased to support the overall direction you have outlined.

We are particularly encouraged by the emphasis on harmonization throughout the Strategic Plan. For plan sponsors and administrators, greater consistency across jurisdictions makes it easier to administer pension plans, reduces unnecessary complexity and costs, and, as the establishment of pension plan is voluntary on the part of employers, this ultimately benefits employees through pension coverage.

With respect to Priority 1.3, it would be very helpful for stakeholders to know which existing CAPSA guidelines you anticipate reviewing or updating over the planning period, and in what rough sequence. Even a high-level indication of likely priorities would allow the ACPM to plan and allocate the necessary resources so that we can participate constructively and provide you with timely, practical input.
